

Mark Lancaster MP: Cutting taxes for 46,101 in Milton Keynes North and capping increases in benefits

New research has revealed that Conservatives in Government are cutting taxes for 46,101 people in Milton Keynes North from April next year. The Government will lift 1,866 out of tax altogether.

The Government is reforming Labour's 'something for nothing' welfare culture, by capping the amount one household can get in benefits and capping the amount benefits are increased next year. Labour oppose these reforms.

Mark Lancaster commented:
